Providence Federal Credit Union Donates \$5,000 to Providence Portland Medical Clinic Foundation to Help Support "Festival of Trees" Event

Portland, OR, January 22, 2010: Providence Federal Credit Union donated \$5,000 to Providence Portland Medical Clinic Foundation to help co-sponsor the annual Providence Festival of Trees event held in December in Portland, Oregon. In addition, the Credit Union sponsored one of 31 Christmas trees that were auctioned off at their 27th Annual Providence Festival of Trees Gala Dinner and Auction. The beautifully decorated tree was titled "An Art Felt Christmas". Ten talented artists from Verheyden Studios in Boring, Oregon created the masterpieces. Each artist donated an original watercolor painting, which were displayed with the tree. They also made and painted more than 80 papier mache snowman ornaments that hung alongside the hand blown icicles and other decorations. The artfully decorate Christmas tree was auctioned off for \$7,125.
