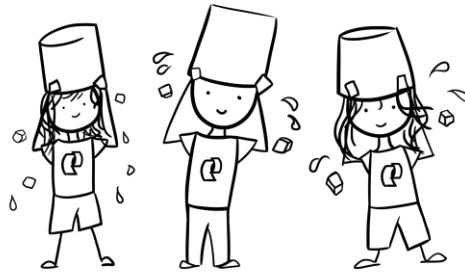

## Providence Federal Credit Union Challenged by Consolidated Community Federal Credit Union to the ALS Ice Bucket Challenge



**Milwaukie, OR, August 22, 2014:** If a nice creamy pie in the face isn't enough, then a big bucket of ice hits the spot for Shirley, Cate, president/CEO of Providence Federal Credit Union. "The pie in the face was part of a fundraiser for the Credit Union Legislative Action Council (CULAC), said Cate. "And, as far as the bucket of ice over my head, well... Consolidated Community Federal Credit Union threw the gauntlet at us and we, of course, couldn't turn down the challenge and the opportunity to donate to a wonderful cause.

So, Friday morning they received a video from their friend and neighbor, Consolidated Community Federal Credit Union, who challenged several credit unions including Providence to the ALS (Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis) bucket challenge. Providence quickly organized their staff at the Administrative office and by the end of the day was able to video the infectious ritual of the ice dumping. In addition, both their Providence St. Vincent Medical Center branch and Providence Office Park 2 (POP 2) branch staffs participated in the ice bucket challenge as well. The Credit Union also donated \$25 for every employee employed at Providence Federal Credit for a total of \$525.

And, like the challenge goes, Cate passed the icy dare to the following: Numerous credit unions in the Pacific Northwest; Providence Federal Credit Union board and supervisory committee; Rod Hochman, president/CEO of Providence Health & Services and Dave Underriner, regional CEO of Providence Health & Services.

"It was all in good fun," said Cate. "But ALS is a serious and unfortunate disease, which as many as 30,000 people between the ages of 40 and 70 have this at any give moment."
