Providence Federal Credit Union teams up with Kells Irish Restaurant for “Green Rain” fundraiser & will match up to \$15,000 to assist medically fragile children at Providence Child Center

Providence Federal Credit Union has partnered with Kells Irish Restaurant & Pub for its annual “Kells Green Rain Fundraiser” to raise money for medically fragile children at Providence Child Center.

From now through February 24th, members can stop by any of their branches and make donations, or go online to donate by visiting their website at www.providencecu.org. Plus, donors will receive a coupon for 20% off of food at Kells Irish Restaurant & Pub. Providence Federal Credit Union and Kells are also selling large one-of-a-kind umbrellas for \$24.99, which all proceeds will benefit Providence Child Center. In addition, patrons at both Kells Irish Restaurant on NW 2nd Ave and Kells Brewpub on NW 21st Ave are invited to toss bills and change into hanging umbrellas from the ceiling. The money will “rain down” from the ceiling and be collected on February 24th and donated to Providence Child Center. Providence Federal Credit Union will then match up to \$15,000 in donations made during the Kells Green Rain Fundraising event.



The center for Medically Fragile Children at Providence Child Center is the Pacific Northwest's only pediatric skilled nursing facility offering 24-hour skilled nursing care for children with profound disabilities and chronic, complex, health needs. From birth to age 21, the center lovingly cares for each child's needs-physically, emotionally, socially, and spiritually so they may grow to reach their full potential. The center relies on donations from the community to bridge the annual \$2 million gap between what Medicaid pays for care and actual costs of providing care for these delightful children.
